



## Cascade Driver Education 2018-19: Fall, Winter & Summer

Fall 2018: Required Parent Meeting Thursday, September 6, 7 pm, HS Room 5. Classes run September 11-October 17, after school from 3:30-5:30 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Drive times on Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Monday.

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Winter 2019: Required Parent Meeting Thursday, January 31, 7 pm, HS Room 5. Classes run February 5-March 12, after school from 3:30-5:30 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Drive times on Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Monday.

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Summer 2019: Required Parent Meeting Tuesday, June 11, 7 pm, HS Room 5. Classes run June 17-July 11 from 9:30-11:30 Monday-Thursday. Students complete 6 drives probably by July 29-August 2.

State law requires a minimum of 30 classroom hours and 12 hours in the vehicle- 6 hours driving and 6 hours observing. We have 16 two-hour classes planned for a total of 32 classroom hours, plus the one hour Parent Night. State law waives the DMV drive test for students who successfully complete an approved driver education program. We are approved.

**Cost:** \$250 or \$175 in district, \$350 or \$275 out of district

**Participants:** Fall & Spring 16 students; Summer up to 30 students

Parent Meeting= Is required for your child to be in Driver Ed class. Make sure at least one parent/guardian/representative **and your student/driver** is at the meeting, where we will finalize our class list, make drive pairs and schedule drive times.

**TimeLines=** Your child must NOT get their license or turn 18 before the end of Driver Ed or you will be required to pay up to \$210 to cover the lost reimbursement from the State. Your child MUST have their learner's permit by the 1<sup>st</sup> class.

**Commitment=** You and your child must commit to all classes and all drives. Driver Education is at the top or near the top priority for the duration of the class. Plan other activities, classes, camps, vacations, etc., with Driver Ed in mind. Thanks!

It is further understood that it is necessary to pay \$250/175 or \$350/275 refundable only if I withdraw 2 days prior to the start of class. Full payment must be made when you enroll. Please make checks payable to "Cascade Driver Ed."

I understand that I am covered by the program's insurance while driving in the education vehicles only, and that I am required to drive **at least 5** additional hours outside of class with a parent/guardian who has insurance coverage on their personal vehicle.

I understand that I must have my Oregon Instruction Permit before the beginning the classroom portion of the course and that I must bring my Oregon Instruction Permit to every behind-the-wheel (BTW) lesson. To cancel a pre-arranged (BTW) lesson, I must notify the instructor at least one day in advance. If I do not bring my driving permit, do not bring my required glasses/contacts, do not appear for a drive, or do not notify the instructor in a timely fashion, I will not be able to drive and this will jeopardize my ability to finish the class.

I realize I must read and agree to comply with the requirements as stated in the Cascade SD Driver Education Program Student / Parent Handbook. The handbook will be handed out the first night of class. It is my responsibility to read the handbook within two days of receiving the copy and then become familiar with the publication including the classroom instruction format, the class expectations, the grading policies, the attendance / tardiness regulations, and class requirements. If I have questions or concerns, I must contact my instructor within the first week.

## Course Agreement of Terms and Conditions

# Cascade SD Driver Education Program

### Dear Student and Parent,

Welcome to the Cascade SD Driver and Traffic Safety Education Program. To be effective, this will not be the “Easy School of Driving.” Your success will require discipline, a willingness to learn new things and perhaps change old habits, and your time. Our program would be incomplete without your active participation, and your collective desire to learn. We highly value the time that you’ll devote to this task and believe that without that commitment, our efforts will be greatly diminished. We want to thank you for your willingness to learn and maintain safe habits that are designed to produce exceptional drivers who are able to freely choose to drive crash and ticket free for an entire lifetime.

**Attendance is mandatory.** The Oregon Department of Transportation - Transportation Safety Division will authorize a certificate of completion only to those individuals who successfully complete the minimum **30 hours of classroom instruction and 12 hours of in-car training** (6-hours of driving and 6-hours of supervised observation). Therefore, students must attend a full 30 hours of classroom and 12 hours of in-car sessions. In addition, students must earn a passing score of 80% on classroom exams, demonstrate mastery of safe driving skills and behaviors in the car, exhibit a positive attitude at all times, and demonstrate the ability to be present and on time for every class and in-car lesson. Any individual who does not successfully complete these stated requirements will not receive a certificate of completion.

**Parents/Mentors:** Guided practice behind the wheel is essential for habit development to occur. Oregon Administrative Rule 737-015-0030 5(d) **requires that you provide a minimum of 5 hours of supervised home practice** for your teen prior to the completion of this course. It further requires that **practice be documented, in the form of a log or other means, demonstrating to the provider** that the requirement has been met. You must submit your practice record prior to receiving a certificate of completion.

**The Department of Motor Vehicles** requires new teen drivers who complete a driver education course to have at least 50 hours of supervised practice before they are eligible to apply for a Provisional License. The Oregon Parent Guide to Teen Driving includes a driving log to keep track of the time you spend practicing. It also contains information and tips you’ll find helpful as you guide your teen through this program.

**The Oregon Attorney General** has recently revised the reimbursement rules for Traffic Safety Education providers. As a result, Approved Providers will not receive state reimbursement for a student who obtains their license prior to course completion. Any student who registers for this course and obtains their license prior to completing the course (both classroom and behind-the-wheel) will be assessed an additional \$210. This fee must be paid before a course completion certificate will be issued.

**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS:** Please review your calendar to ensure there are no conflicts with drive times. If a student has a conflict with an appointed drive time, the student must contact the instructor or the coordinator. This needs to be done no later than the night before the drive, since the instructor may have several drives each day and cannot be reached on short notice. All drives must be completed within 45 days of the end of the classroom sessions. If an instructor has a conflict with an appointed Behind-the-Wheel session, the instructor will contact the student(s) involved. If an instructor has inconveniently changed several drives, please contact Matt McBeth to arrange for a change of instructor as necessary.

**IN-CAR EXPECTATIONS:**

1. No food or beverages at any time
2. The driver-training car should be as clean when you leave it as it was when you arrived
3. The drive begins promptly at scheduled time
4. Absences must be pre-excused
5. Neither students nor the instructor will be under the influence of any intoxicant during the class or behind the wheel instruction

**Student Impairment at class or behind-the-wheel.** Should a student show up at class or for a drive under the influence of intoxicants, parents shall be notified to pick up the student and all school district discipline, including athletic participation consequences, shall ensue.

The student must bring a valid driving permit to all behind-the-wheel sessions. A student will not be allowed to drive and will be considered absent if his/her permit is not available. Students must wear appropriate clothing and shoes to class. No sandals, flip-flops, or heels are allowed in the car. We suggest students wear comfortable, securely fitted shoes. Appropriate corrective lenses are required and sunglasses are highly recommended.

**CLASS AND BEHIND-THE-WHEEL MAKE-UP:**

Students are implored to not miss any class time. Make-up of missed classes needs to be scheduled with the instructor.

**Please text the teacher at 503/910-5474 if you are running late for a Drive.** We have some flexibility, but not much... depends on when your drive is scheduled. Also, the teacher would like to go home at some point in time. If the student has missed a behind-the-wheel session (not pre-excused!), arrangements can be made for a make-up session.
